

## Returned from the Front



The 'Returned from the Front' project was created to develop a focus on the repatriation of grave markers from the battlefields of the Great War. Sometimes known as battlefield crosses, there are hundreds of examples across Great Britain and further afield. They can be found in churches, chapels, memorial halls, museums and occasionally in private residences. Each one represents a person's death and is also part of a story; a trail of memory, of commemoration from the battlefields and the symbolic return of the dead back home.
